

5-0.5 seconds after full engine operation, the RPM starts to fall from about 6000RPMs to a few hundred RPMs. It is not always noticeable to the eye, but once the engine is under full power, the descent is noticeable, and an idle will not make it go away.

I've noticed this is a problem in real life aircraft also, both airplanes and helicopters. It is quite annoying, because it throws a wobble in the aircraft. This can be corrected with no difficulty, but when you have a 40% power and you're climbing, or 45% power and you're going to cruise, you lose that power that you gained by doing the engine up, when you hit the wobble. And it feels very bad, and I am wondering if it is a CFM fault, or if there is a workaround. Any help, please? A: The quick answer is that the engine manufacturer for that aircraft model is a friend of mine and he has confirmed that the engine manufacturer has an altitude bellow 6000 RPM which results in the engine losing a bit of power and is solved by taking the engine to full power after that point. He said that this is a fix that has been put in place for the Airbus A320. The longer answer is that there are many factors that affect power and with that much power going through a single engine, things can change at any time during operation. For example, you may be in cruise at a point when you can actually use more power, but you've already hit your maximum thrust and the engine loses a bit of power to get the engine at its max speed. And there are a lot of other factors. I would recommend doing a little more research to understand that relationship between the power curves and the RPM curves.
